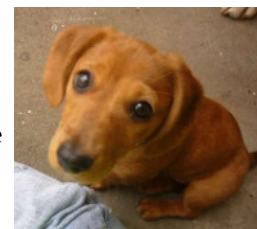

We are still working with Shelby Humane Society to sponsor a van for the Shelter Partners program -- the next van is scheduled to leave on December 31st! Stay tuned for more.

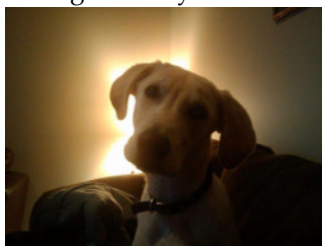
### \* Pet Spotlight \*

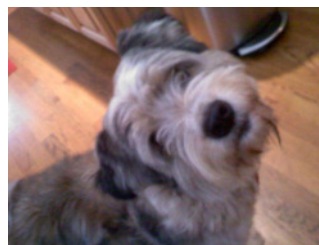

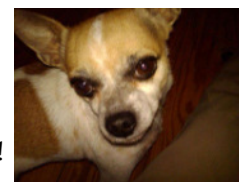
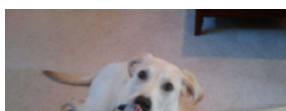
### Say hello to more of our wonderful pet friends!

Today, Shadow is doing GREAT! We've continued to



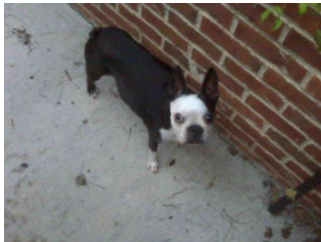

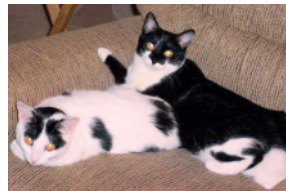
